Changes to Grappenhall Hall Special School

The Local Authority is proposing to make changes to Grappenhall Hall Special School with effect from 1 September 2015 as follows:

- To relocate the school to Green Lane, Padgate, Warrington, WA1 4JL;
- To change the age range of pupils admitted to the school from pupils aged 11 to 16, to pupils aged 5 to 16;
- To provide a total number of 72 places at the school which includes 16 places for pupils aged 5-11 and 56 places for pupils aged 11-16.

In addition, the Governors of the school have also decided to change the name of the school if the proposal is implemented. It is proposed that the name of the school at the new site will be Woolston Brook Special School.

The Local Authority is required to provide you with a copy of the statutory notice that was published on 2 April setting out these changes.
